## MAY 18th MOBEACH SILHOUETTES

Hi There Competitors

Here's one we haven't done in a few years. It's based on NRA Silhouette competition, and it will be .22 Ir only.

Now since it's not an NRA sanctioned match, we will play by MoBeach rules.

Classes will be MoBeach Open, Match & Sport.

Relays will be every hour on the hour at 8 a.m., 9 a.m., 10 a.m., 11 a.m & 12 p.m.

Please check in at least 20 minutes before the start of your assigned relay, so we will have plenty of time for a course of fire briefing. I can't stress this enough!!

Reservations for a preferred relay must be made by emailing Tony Almeida DIRECTLY! Use <u>aalmeida0229@gmail.com</u>

Competitors will be assigned either Group #1, or Group #2, and a bench number. Bench numbers will be clearly marked.

Distances for this event will be 25 yards, 50 yards, 75 yards, & 100 yards.

Competitors should have these scope adjustments available because there will be NO SIGHTING SHOTS.

Group #1 will start on the left side of the range, engaging 10 targets at 25 yards, with 10 rounds, front and rear support in 5 minutes, per range instructions.

Pause to reload & readjust for next targets.

Group #1 will next engage 10 targets at 75 yards, with 10 rounds, front support and rear support in 5 minutes, per range instructions.

Pause to reload & adjust position.

Group #2 will start on the right side of the range, engaging 10 targets at 50 yards, with 10 rounds, front and rear support in 5 minutes, per range instructions.

Pause to reload & adjust for next targets.

Group #2 will next engage 10 targets at 100 yards, with 10 rounds, front and rear support in 5 minutes, per range instructions.

Pause to reload & adjust position.

At the half way point of the match, Competitors will be instructed to move to the assigned numbered bench at the opposite side of the range.

Meaning, Group #1 goes to the right side of the range, and Group #2 goes to the left side of the range. Don't worry, a designated responsible adult will happily tell you where to go, and when!

At this point Competitors will engage the targets at the distances they have not yet competed at, and it the manner described for those distances.

For this event it is MANDATORY for Competitors to have a chamber flag for SAFE movement of their rifle on the range and follow safety instructions EXPLICITLY!

If you do not bring a MANDATORY chamber flag, you will be charged \$1 for an ad hoc flag to use during the match, but you can keep it forever !

So come and have a great time while testing your skills, being with like-minded shooters, and enjoying the muffins.
